ESCI-UPF's <u>ICT</u> Department provides technical support to resolve day-today issues with ICT tools and manages access to internal services (eduroam, printing services, the school's IT equipment, etc.) and the internet.

This online learning platform offers additional support to in-person teaching. You'll find information on course subjects, lesson notes, assignments, messages, etc., as well as tools for taking online exams.

SIGMA

This tool lets you manage academic details such as:

- Your enrolment
- Your fees
- Your academic transcript
- Your timetable
- Your grades for each term
- Academic procedures

Eduroam

This international roaming service gives users in research and higher education centres easy and secure network access when visiting an institution other than their own.

You can access the eduroam Wi-Fi network at ESCI-UPF and other universities worldwide with the electronic credentials linked to your ESCI-UPF email account.

Office 365

All ESCI-UPF students can use their university email account to sign up for Office 365 Education for free, including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote and Microsoft Teams.

Academic Management

This department centralises, coordinates and handles all matters, procedures and formalities in the academic life of students taking Bachelor's and Master's degrees. <u>You can carry out these formalities.</u> To communicate with Academic Management you should always use your ESCI-UPF e-mail address.
